5. Have you accepted that God cannot tolerate sin? Have you accepted God's offer to have Christ bear the curse for sin for you?
6. Take time to pray with your group and consider the severity of our sin and the gracious gift of salvation in Christ. Reflect on Galatians 3:10-14 and praise God for his salvation in Jesus.
