

**Faithfulness in Sex | Titus 1**  
**Sermon Discussion Questions**  
**September 29, 2019**

1. In today's sermon, Pastor Jim outlined a believer's responsibility to faithfulness in regards to sex both in marriage and outside of a marriage relationship. Was there anything from today's sermon that stood out to you?
2. As we consider faithfulness in one particular area of life today, let's review - what does it mean to be faithful? Who are we called to be faithful to in the context of this message?
3. Pastor Jim stated that sex is a gift from God and that he designed sex as a way for two separate individuals to become one. This was illustrated by two separate pieces of wood joined together to form an inseparable bond. However, the same language is also used to describe the intimacy that can take place between us and God and also between us and other believers. Discuss ways, whether you are married or single, that you have experienced this type of oneness.
4. God sent Jesus so that no matter what our history with sexual brokenness and sin may be. We can be washed, made holy and declared righteous based on what Jesus did for us. Spend some time thanking God for this amazing gift. Spend some time asking God to heal any sexual brokenness you, or a loved one, may still be carrying.
5. Jim lays out four principles for believers to follow with sex. Review the principles given to those who are unmarried and to those who are married. In what ways does following these principles bring freedom? In what ways does it feel like a struggle to engage faithfully with this gift from the Lord?
6. Commit as a group to submitting to God's rules for us in the area of sex, knowing that they are ultimately for our good and for the good of our loved ones. Pray together that God would help you be faithful.
