What are some of the ways we see this belief impacting people's understanding of their relationship with God today? How have you tried to confront this belief in yourself or in your circles?
4. How has God matured your understanding of how someone is "good" with Him?
5. If salvation is good news, and the message is not difficult, and delivering the message is not difficult, why are we not doing more of it?
6. Will you commit to sharing one name, with your group, of a person in your life you will deliver the Good News to this week?
