**Titus 1:8**  
**Sermon Discussion Questions**  
**November 24, 2019**

1. In Pastor Tom's introduction, he mentions that sin leads to hurt, pain and difficulty, while obedience leads to life, freedom and peace. Have you found this to be true in your life? As you look back at some of topics Titus has chosen for us, have you made any tangible changes in your life that would reflect obedience over sin?
2. Pastor Tom mentioned that to be holy is to break away from things that cause us to conform to our culture. Can you think of anything in your life that is holding you back from the blessing He has for you due to conforming with the culture? What changes might you need to make today?
3. Are you currently yoked with someone that according to 2 Corinthians, you shouldn't be? Think about those in your life who are not believers. Are there relationships that God is calling you to break away from?
4. Are there relationships with unbelievers that he is calling you to strengthen so you can be an ambassador for Him? What would it look like for you to grow these relationships?
5. Share an example in your life where you preferred to stay in your Christian bubble rather than be a sheep among wolves in the culture. Is this still a struggle for you? What preconceived thoughts must be removed so that you can see/find joy in influencing the culture for Christ?
6. Spend time this week doing an honest assessment of yourself regarding if your life is distinctly different than the culture. If it isn't, begin to pray for guidance as to how to live a holy life for God and the things/people that may need to be removed in the process. Also, spend time this week praying for body of Christ that we remember the call to be distinctly different; to be holy and righteous people for God that live in the world and are not of it.
