4)	Why are spiritual gifts so important and necessary for the Church? What happens to the Church when we don't exercise our gift?
5)	How can you use your spiritual gifts in evangelism?
6)	Does the way we exercise our gift matter, or is it just that we do exercise our gift (See 1 st Peter 4:10-11 and Romans 12:3-8)?
7)	Has the Spirit been prompting you to do something new or different in your life? If so, what?
