SPIRITUAL GIFTS

- 1. **Evangelism:** The gift of evangelism is the ability and desire to boldly and clearly communicate the gospel of Jesus Christ so that non-Christians can become Christians.
- 2. **Prophet:** The gift of being a prophet is the ability to proclaim God's truth.
- 3. **Teacher:** The gift of teacher is the ability to communicate God's word clearly and simply.
- 4. **Encouragement/Exhortation:** The gift of encouragement/ exhortation involves motivating, encouraging, and consoling others so they mature in their walk with Jesus.
- 5. **Shepherd:** The gift of being a shepherd is the ability to care for the needs of other believers.
- 6. **Mercy:** The gift of mercy is the capacity to feel and express unusual compassion and sympathy for those in difficult or crisis situations and provide them with the necessary help and support to see them through tough times.
- 7. **Serving:** The gift of serving is the ability to joyfully work alongside another and help that person complete the task God has given them
- 8. **Giving:** The gift of giving is the ability to give money and other forms of wealth joyfully, wisely and generously to meet the needs of others and help support ministries.
- 9. **Administration:** The gift of administration is the ability to organize and lead others in the church.
