

Sermon Questions

Hebrews 1

“The End of the Story”

1. Pastor Jim mentioned that the journey of faith we are on is about a personal relationship with God as our Father. Read Psalm 63:6-8 and Isaiah 41:8-10. How do these verses convey God as our Father leading and guiding us?
2. Read Matthew 6:26-34. How does Jesus describe our heavenly Father taking care of us as His children?
3. Read Rom. 8:17; Gal. 4:6-7; and 1 Peter 2:10. What are some of the benefits of being a child of God that you see highlighted in these verses?
4. The second thing we learn from Jesus’ story is that God rewards the love of righteousness and the hatred of wickedness (Heb. 1:8-9). Jesus tells us, “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness for they will be filled.” Read Psalm 119:11; Rom. 8:13; and Col. 4:2. How can we practically pursue God and a life of righteousness?
5. The third thing we learn from the story of Jesus comes from Heb. 1:10-12. God gave Jesus eternal life and this is the reward for all who follow him by faith. Even though we are waiting now, God will make all things right and restore every wrong. What does Joel 2:25 promise to all who have experienced loss?
6. Take time to pray together. Pray for one another that God would strengthen and encourage you through your journey of faith. Praise God that you are a child of God and reflect on all of the benefits that come from that!
