4)	What was the metaphor Pastor Jim used in his sermon to explain the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of a Christian? Was this a helpful way to think about it? In what ways did it clarify or augment your understanding of the Spirit's role in life?
5)	What are the implications of the Holy Spirit being the author of the script?
6)	What are the implications of the Holy Spirit being the interpreter of the script?
7)	What are different ways that you can live out the truth from this message?
