2)	Why would the Father cut off a branch? What does this mean in literal terms, why would He "cut off" a believer today?
3)	Why would the Father prune a branch? What is the purpose of pruning?
4)	What does it mean to "abide" or "remain" in Christ? What are you personally doing to remain in Christ? How can you, as a small group, spur one another on to more faithfully remain in Christ?
5)	What is the difference between trying to bear fruit on your own and bearing fruit by remaining in Christ? How do the two look different?
6)	Is there some you can think of for whom this is a good encouragement or a good warning? Why would you or wouldn't you want to tell them about this passage and Pastor Jim's teaching?
