

Sermon Questions

“The Fellowship of the Holy Spirit”

2 Corinthians 13:14

1. Last week, Pastor Tom shared with us about the love of God. Share together a time where you experienced God’s love from your week. How did this affect your walk with Christ?
2. What stood out to you in this week’s message?
3. The Holy Spirit is a part of the Trinity, which consists of all three members of the Godhead: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We as Christians usually recognize God the Father and His Son, Jesus, but we often forget about the Holy Spirit. Why do we tend to neglect the Holy Spirit when we talk about God? How can we become more “Trinity-centered” in our worship?
4. Pastor Tom told us that the Greek word for fellowship is “koinonia.” Throughout Scripture, we see koinonia described in different ways: partnership, unity, communion, distribution, joint participation, intimacy, community and sharing. Read Acts 2:42-47. What would happen if our koinonia looked like the early church’s experience with the Spirit? How would the world see God differently if we embodied this type of koinonia in our lives?
5. At the end of the message, Calvary members shared their own stories of experiencing koinonia (fellowship). These stories highlighted the Holy Spirit’s power, partnership, and participation in their lives. Reflect on your own lives. How have you seen the Holy Spirit make His presence and power known in your small group, your Sunday school class, your family’s life, etc.? Go around and share examples of koinonia with one another.
6. Take some time to pray with one another. First, think back to the first two weeks of the series. Praise God for the gift of his grace and his unconditional love. For this week, read and pray through the following Scriptures that speak about the Holy Spirit. Ask God to help you reorient your lives around these Scriptures:
