**Sermon Discussion Questions**

1. What are some things you were most thankful for this Easter? What does Easter help you remember?
2. What were some things in this Sunday's sermon that stuck out to you?
3. In our culture we can typically think of neighbors as those who live next to us, but in the case of the parable it was someone who was lying in a roadway. Have you ever considered those who you encounter, maybe on an errand or elsewhere around the city, as your neighbor?
4. Looking at Luke 10, what were some of the things that the Good Samaritan did for this individual? What may be some modern day examples of these things?
5. In Jesus' day the Jewish people and the Samaritans did not have a very hospitable relationship, so this story would have been highly agitating. Are there people groups, political parties, social classes, occupations, economic statuses, or other factors that you struggle with being merciful toward?

For example, some may see a homeless person and have the initial thought that helping them means they will go on to buy drugs or alcohol. What are some ways we as a community can do better at loving all those around us?
