## Sermon Discussion Questions January 31, 2021

Special Note: In light of Revelation 1:3, please read the passage for this week's study questions aloud as a group before going through the questions.

- Last week the sermon was on deception and we were challenged to be a witness that will
  walk alongside others who are deceived or to suffer for the sake of God's glory. What has
  God been sharing with you this week in regards to being this witness? Share an example (if
  you have one) of how you've started or have been a witness this week for someone who is
  deceived.
- 2. **Read together Mark 1:15.** What parallels do you notice between this scripture and our scripture in Revelation 11? What difference do you notice? What is our call/responsibility from Mark in light of what's shared in Revelation 11?
- 3. **Read together John 12:31, 14:30, and 16:11.** What does Jesus refer to Satan as? How does this relate to the evil and persecution experienced in the world for being a Christian? When you read Revelation 11:15, what happens to Satan?
- 4. **Read together Revelation 1:8 & 4:8.** What difference do you notice when you read those passages in light of Revelation 11:17? Why did John make this subtle change in Revelation 11? How does it secure our victory in the future?
- 5. With the charge of being on the right team/Team Jesus, how does this change our attitudes and the way we act towards others? In light of everything that's going on in our culture, how can you be more kingdom-minded to embody the team you're on?
- 6. Spend time praying together that you would you would live in the reality of the victory you have because of Jesus. Also, pray for opportunities and boldness to share the victory you have with others who may be on the opposing team.
