Sermon Discussion Questions
March 28, 2021

Special Note: In light of Revelation 1:3, please read the passage for this week's study questions aloud as a group before going through the questions.

1. Pastor Jim asked us to think about different wedding moments. What are some of the most memorable wedding moments you've experienced? What made them memorable?
2. Jesus's first ever miracle is recorded in John 2 at the wedding in Cana. **Read John 2:1-12** aloud as a group. Besides the miracle, what are a few things in this scene that makes this wedding memorable?
3. Revelation 19:1-4 gives us a picture of a multitude of people celebrating the destruction of evil. This seems like a strange thing to be celebrating at a wedding but think about a time and share with the group about when God removed a sin, something destructive, unhealthy, or abusive in your life.
4. Our passage today gives a beautiful picture of the great wedding of eternity coming in the future. Pastor Jim mentioned all the preparation that goes into an earthly wedding, next Sunday we'll be celebrating Easter and the Resurrection our invitation to the heavenly wedding. What are some things that you can do during Holy Week to prepare for the heavenly wedding coming in the future?
5. A couple of the practices in the wedding ceremony are the pronouncement of the bride and groom as well as putting on the wedding ring. The purpose of these practices is to announce to the world that you're married to this particular person. In what ways as a Christian, as the Church (bride of Christ), can we invite others into this heavenly wedding that we've been invited to? Close your time in prayer for individuals, friends, family members who you could invite to church this coming Easter Sunday.
