

Sermon Discussion Questions
April 11, 2021

Special Note: In light of Revelation 1:3, please read the passage for this week's study questions aloud as a group before going through the questions.

1. There are a lot of events in the timeline of Revelation and at times, it can feel confusing as to where we are, what's happened, and what's occurring next. Could you explain the events and timeline of Revelation? As a group exercise, walk through the [timeline](#) together answering any questions some may have over the events that occur.
2. As a group, **read Revelation 3:21**. If we endure in this life by the power of the Spirit, we will reign with Jesus. Does this future reality encourage you through what you may be enduring now? Why is it difficult to focus ourselves on the future when it will be better than the present?
3. As a group, **read Isaiah 65:20-25**. From this poetic description, share some insights you see that speak into the joy of the millennial kingdom. What can you do now to live in the reality of this kingdom in the present?
4. Revelation 20:2 speaks of Satan being bound for 1000 years before he's released and eventually thrown into the lake of fire. Do you believe that spiritual warfare happens in the life of a believer today? What examples could you provide? Does it provide comfort knowing that Satan's demise will happen in the future?
5. Revelation 20:11-15 speaks of the somber reality of what will happen to those who choose to reject Christ. They will experience judgement from the Father and will be thrown into the lake of fire. This means that many of our neighbors, friends and even relatives will be at this judgment. How is God using you now to speak to these people? Is there fear or other things that keeping you from talking to other about Christ.
6. Spend time praying for one another for boldness to share the gospel. Spend time praying by name for those the Lord is calling you to speak with that they would have an open heart to hear and receive the message of salvation.
