1. In what ways did this sermon challenge you? In what ways did it encourage you?
2. Based on Genesis 2, at creation, we have more than just biological sex. We have also been given a gender. Have you considered gender a gift from God? How does your perception of gender shift when you consider that both are created in the image of God?
3. In our sermon we hear that gender dysphoria/incongruence is not simply a current issue, but one that has existed since ancient times. This means that the church has been dealing with by these struggles since the beginning. Can you be encouraged knowing that God hasn't forgotten about those who have this struggle?

Are you encouraged that the church has still grown, and that God loves and preserves us through the ages?

How can Calvary support you regarding these struggles?

4. In this message we see how each and every one of us are born with some sort of broken desire. We tend to desire things contrary to God's holy expectations for our lives. How does this help us have compassion for people who struggle in ways that we don't? How does this help us understand that the sin of not submitting yourself to your given gender is no greater than other sins?
5. Many who struggle with gender dysphoria/incongruence internalize their gender as a primary feature of who they are. The core of their identity is often wrapped in gender and sexuality. How can you engage with those struggling in this area in truth and love? What can you do now? Do you know anyone struggles with these issues? Would you connect them with Calvary Church? Is there anything Calvary do to help you help others?
