Sermon Discussion Questions October 24, 2021

1. Have you become numb to death, or is death jarring to you? We are told that "death and taxes" are the only certain things in this life. Do you feel this is true about death (not taxes)?

How does death remind us of the consequences of sin?

How does knowing that we have eternal life in Christ change the way we think about death in our lives?

2. Do you tend to skip over genealogies in Scripture? For example, Shem, Ham and Japheth show up frequently in Genesis (Ham shows up in Psalms).

Did this sermon help you appreciate the value of these portions of Scripture?

3. Do you walk with God, or just visit?

How can you walk with God better?

What can you do daily to remind yourself to walk with God? How can Calvary Church help you walk daily, and constantly with God?

4. In 1 Corinthians 15 it says that death is the last enemy to be destroyed. This means that there is a death for death. Another way to say it is, that life, God, love, all of us in Christ, will outlast death. How can this truth encourage you in your Christian walk? Does this help you feel the weight of your choices today? Why, or why not?
