Sermon Discussion Questions

1. Thinking of how lonely Noah must have felt building the ark: do you ever feel alone or disconnected in your workplace or school or extracurricular activity because you follow Jesus?

Is there a way that your small group can support you in this? Are there specific things that we can be praying for to help with this feeling?

If you are not feeling lonely at your job, are there ways in which you can encourage your small group to walk boldly and connect with others while you follow Jesus in your job, school, or extracurricular activity?

2. In Genesis 6:6 it says that “The LORD regretted that he had made human beings on the earth, and his heart was deeply troubled”. Does considering how God feels about the wickedness of sinful humans change the way you view God? What do you think it means when God “regrets”? Do God’s emotions help you change the way you think about sin? Why, or why not?
3. Have you ever followed God’s instructions even when it may not have made sense to a lot of the people around you? Can you share with your group what that experience was and how you saw God work through your circumstance?
4. If we consider that work (any kind of work) was given to us before the fall, could we consider it as being something we do into eternity (without the effects of the fall)?
5. Can you see work being considered as worship? Does thinking about work in this way change the way in you engage with work now?
