Sermon Discussion Questions

1. When was the last time you shared the Gospel with someone outside of church? How did it go? If it has been a while since you've shared the Gospel, why is that?
2. Matthew 28 tells us that all believers have Jesus' authority to obey the Great Commission and the assurance of His presence with us as we do so. Do you have the assurance of Christ's Presence? In other words, do you believe that Jesus Christ, by His Spirit, indwells all believers? If so, do you try to listen to and obey God's voice at all times? What hinders most when you try to do it? How could Calvary help you when you struggle?
3. One of three tasks of believers in the Great Commission is teaching them to obey all of Christ's commands. What do you think is the best to teach the next generation about following Christ's commands? How could church and home education work together in order to hand down the Christian legacy to the next generation?
