1. What was your understanding of meekness before this week's sermon? How has it changed? How is this similar or different to the message we heard a couple weeks ago about being "poor in spirit"?
2. What type of people do you see succeeding in worldly matters? Where in your life or in what situations has anger and frustration caused you to stumble away from meekness?
3. In what ways have you sought vengeance for yourself? Have you been willing or are you willing to entrust this desire for vengeance to God? How can Moses' good example encourage you to do the same?
4. What power or position of authority has God given you where you can display meekness? Or has this been difficult to display because of that power or authority?
5. When you are struggling with sin what type of person would you like to help you? How does this help you think about how you should help others when they are struggling with sin?
6. How does being a "meek" person, or taking on "meekness" as a characteristic, help you to shine your light brighter and bring more glory to God?
7. How are you being asked to display meekness this week? What cares do you need to roll onto God right now?
