1. How do you feel and react when you realize that the opposition to you is growing in your workplace, community, or home?
2. Jesus did not come to be served but to serve. How has this statement about his person affected your life? If it has not, how can this challenge the way you view others? What does being a servant like Jesus look like on a daily basis? How do you be a servant when you are in a position of authority like Jesus was?
3. Jesus came to do the will of God the Father who sent him. What do you think God's will is for your life? How do you live to fulfill His will for the Kingdom of God?
4. What do you think about the statement, "Jesus came to solve man's problem; not men's problems?" As Christians, how does God equip us to live in this tension?
5. Read 2 Timothy 2:23-26 and Titus 3:1-5.
6. How do we implement Jesus' method in Matthew 12:19 to the issues of today? What does it look like in your politics? In the issues of race and equality? In the issue of abortion rights? In the LGBTQ+ movement? Who do you suppose are the broken reeds and smoldering wicks in each of these areas that need to hear about Jesus' person and mission?
