1. Which of these contrasts (broad/narrow, many/few, destruction/life, entering/entering and finding) stuck out to you most as you listened to the message this week?
2. If a Christian friend came to you for guidance about a decision they were making, how would you counsel them in light of this message? What questions would you have for them? What about if a non-Christian came to you asking for the same advice?
3. Is there a time when you chose to walk on the broad road? At the time did you feel this was the right road to take? What justifications did you give for this choice?
4. When or where do you feel tempted to take the broad road instead of the narrow road? What constraints do you find on the narrow road? How have you found life on the narrow road?
5. Does the narrow road ever feel lonely to you? Where do you go to feel God's presence with you on the narrow road? What do you hold onto when it is hard? How can your friends help to come alongside you when you are feeling lonely?
6. Which road do you find yourself on today? Where do you feel God challenging you to put your theology into practice and practically be on the narrow road?
7. How can we keep each other accountable to staying on the narrow road?
