1. In your own life, how do you practically show that you love God with all your heart, soul, and mind?
2. Other than Jesus' temptation as explained in this sermon, where in scripture do you see Jesus as an example of how we ought to love God with all our heart, soul, and mind? How do you see him love his neighbors as himself?
3. In which of the three categories, heart, soul, and mind, do you find it hardest to display love to God? In which of these three categories do you find yourself more susceptible to temptation? How do you combat this and turn your heart, soul, or mind back to God in those moments?
4. How would you define being a disciple? What are the essential aspects of being a disciple?
5. What would it look like to simply be a part of the crowd today rather than a disciple? How do you differentiate between members of the crowd and disciples?
6. This week, how can you be an engaged disciple rather just a part of the crowd?
7. What are some ways you feel loved by Jesus? Who has God put in your life who you can love like Jesus in obedience to this command to love your neighbor as yourself?
