3. According to verses 16 & 17 what are Solomon's thoughts concerning justice? Can you relate to this tension?
4. (See verse 15) What are some ways we are tempted to become a judge and take finding a solution to injustice into our own hands? How is God inviting you to place your hope in Jesus as the judge?
5. According to 1 Peter 2:23, how should we react when we are treated unjustly?
6. Consider 1 Corinthians 5:5 and Matthew 5. Why does judging prematurely not change things? How does love change everything?
7. How do we love our enemy's and not judge prematurely during this election season?
